FACULTY & STUDENT TB REQUIREMENTS – Sherri Hanrahan, Chris Vandenhouten, Brian Krogh

The CDC has changed their TB guidelines. The GGBHA's current TB policy is costly and time consuming for documentation. The GGBHA has overwhelmingly agreed, based on recent survey results, to align with the new requirements. Students and faculty going to a site outside the GGBHA will need to follow that site's TB policy.

Approved TB Health Requirements Based on CDC Recommendations for Health Care Workers:

Baseline (preplacement) TB screening using a two-step TB skin test or single blood assay test IGRA (e.g., Quantiferon Gold, TB-Spot, etc.) for those without documented prior TB disease or Latent TB Infection (LTBI) on admission to the program. Annual TB education and completion of an Annual TB Questionnaire

For those with a history of TB disease or LTBI, an initial post-positive chest X-Ray and symptom evaluation is required to rule out TB disease. Follow-up will be determined by the facility.

Health systems require employees to go through an annual TB education; the CDC website has TB course that could be potentially assigned to students to go with their questionnaires. See link: CDC TB module (Lessons 1-6): <https://www.cdc.gov/tb/webcourses/TB101/index.html>

GGBHA forms will be updated to reflect the change. HealthCare systems might have a different policy related to their TB policy so the academic setting would have to accommodate for that student/s.
