Guest Speakers – Kari Mueller (NEWAHEC) and Rebecca Deschane (Vice President, Talent Development, New North, Inc.)

NEWAHEC is looking to re-engage with NE region academic and healthcare agencies. They are applying for a grant and would like to develop a taskforce with members of GGBHA on opportunities to grow and enhance our healthcare. The timeline will depend on the grant which is due in March.

This initiative aims to address critical workforce challenges and enhance collaboration across our region. The four key areas include:

1. **Establishing a Regional Healthcare Alliance** – Strengthening coordination and advocacy efforts.
2. **Attracting & Retaining the Healthcare Workforce** – Developing innovative strategies to address workforce shortages.
3. **Expanding Career Exploration for Secondary & Post-Secondary Students** – Enhancing opportunities to engage the next generation of healthcare professionals.
4. **Continuing High-Quality Clinical Placements** – Ensuring strong partnerships for student training and professional development.

Bellin Health Update: (S. Hanrahan provided an update for Kelly Verhasselt) They are still working with MCE and academic partners to work out kinks. There was also a concern received regarding the
