

**Wisconsin Healthcare Alliance - Immunization & Health Requirements  
for Students / Advanced Practice Providers / Residents**

<b>MMR Measles, Mumps &amp; Rubella</b>	Documentation of 2 Doses of Vaccines; <b>OR</b> Positive Rubella, Rubeola, & Mumps Titers Documented Serologic Immunity (titer) Must be appropriately spaced and given according to CDC guidelines (after first birthday).
<b>Varicella</b>	Two (2) Varicella Vaccination Dates <b>OR</b> Positive Varicella Titer
<b>Influenza Vaccine</b>	November 1 to March 31 for Fall session/semester, <b>and</b> prior to any Winter/Spring session/semester. Students/advanced practice providers/residents in clinicals/rotations between April 1 and October 31 are exempt from the flu requirement. If a student/advanced practice provider/resident requests an "exemption", he/she will need to follow the site policy.
<b>Tdap, Tetanus, Diphtheria &amp; Pertussis</b>	Documentation of a one-time dose of the Tdap vaccine and then Td every 10 years.
<b>Hepatitis B Vaccination</b>	HEPLISAV-B (2 Vaccine Series) <b>OR</b> Hepatitis B (3 Vaccine Series), <b>OR</b> Post Vaccination Antibody Screen - This is a series of either two or three vaccinations and post vaccination antibody screen. The vaccination series is voluntary but is highly recommended for all students/advanced practice providers/residents in a health career field. <b>OR</b> a Positive Hepatitis B Antibody Titer <b>OR</b> Signed Declination Form
<b>Tuberculin Test</b>	<b>Baseline</b> (preplacement) TB screening using a two-step TB skin test or single blood assay test IGRA (e.g., QuantiFERON Gold, TB-Spot, etc.) for those without documented prior TB disease or Latent TB Infection (LTBI) on admission to the program. <b>Annual</b> TB education and completion of an Annual TB Questionnaire <a href="https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/forms/f02314.pdf">https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/forms/f02314.pdf</a> <i>For those with a history of TB disease or LTBI, an initial post-positive chest X-Ray and symptom evaluation is required to rule out TB disease. Follow-up will be determined by the facility.</i>
<b>Positive Post TB Skin Test Conversion – Chest X-ray</b>	If a student/advanced practice provider/resident received a positive PPD result, he/she must provide the following documentation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Positive TB skin test results</li> <li>• Negative chest x-ray dated post positive TB skin test conversion</li> <li>• Complete annual health symptom TB specific questionnaire</li> </ul> If a student/advanced practice provider/resident is positive for active TB disease, he/she must participate in an active treatment plan to be reviewed annually. The student/advanced practice provider/resident is not eligible to participate in clinical practicum/rotation until the medical provider determines he/she is not communicable.
<b>Physical Exam &amp; Health Hx</b>	Physical exams may be required by certain agencies.
<b>COVID Vaccination</b>	The COVID vaccine may be required by certain agencies. COVID guidelines and deadlines need to be followed per agency. An approved exemption from one agency does <u>not</u> mean exemption from other agencies.
<b>Medical Conditions/Injuries Requiring Immediate Student/Advanced Practice Provider/Resident Restrictions</b>	Students/advanced practice providers/residents are responsible to immediately notify their school/college designee of sudden changes in their medical conditions/injuries <u>prior</u> to the next scheduled clinical day.
<b>Drug Screen</b>	Drug screens may be required by certain agencies.
<b>CPR &amp; CPR Renewal</b>	American Heart Association BLS training must be completed within the last two years. Heartsaver and online-only classes without a classroom skills component are <u>not</u> acceptable for health professionals.

**IMPORTANT:** Health care requirements are determined by the organization and the GGBHA, not by a specific department within an organization. A specific department or unit cannot add to and/or change these requirements.
