## Website Metrics & Billing Update

## New North Workforce Initiative Update

- February 4 meeting was canceled: next meeting scheduled for March 4.
- Brian confirmed he can attend; Sherri may also attend depending on availability.
- If Sherri is unavailable, Brian will take notes to share at the next meeting.

## Review of Mandatory Modules

### Module: HIPPA Privacy and Security

- Slide 25 replace phrasing “...can lead to termination” to “can lead to dismissal from clinical rotation.”
- Slide 32 change “ ... talk to your leader!” to “... talk to your Instructor.”

### Module: Infection Prevention

- Slide 10 correct bullet to read: after caring for a patient with known or suspected infections and/or diarrhea.
- Slide 36 remove irrelevant distractors such as “air conditioning, sweaters, scarves.” Add one realistic distractor to knowledge checks: “Wearing gloves for the entire shift.”
- Slide 45 revise instructions from “Report the exposure promptly to your instructor, the department supervisor, employee health, or infection preventionist at the facility” to “Report the exposure immediately to your instructor and department leader.”
- Slide 62 PPE reuse clarification, add: PPE is single-use only and must not be reused.
- Slide 79, first bullet: change from “Know where to throw” to “Know where to dispose.”

### Module: Professional Expectations in the Workplace

- Slide 9 ADIET keep the content but rephrase it too: This is one example of a communication tool some clinical agencies may use.

- Slide 16 discussion included changing bullet 1 from the National Academy of Medicines standards to AMA Code of Ethics to reflect the correct citation; however, on further review, NAM is correct so no change will be made.
- Slide 30 add direct language: Students must keep phones with their personal belongings during clinical. Personal phone use is only appropriate during non-clinical times.
- Discussion included adding a comment about daith piercings for migraines; however, it was decided not to be added. Students can request this through accommodation requests. Statements about school badge reels and fake eyelashes were also discussed, but no wording was felt to be needed at this time.

- No changes.
